Veloura 360 uses focused electromagnetic energy to stimulate the pelvic-floor musculature while the patient remains seated and fully clothed.

01 Focused muscle stimulation

Electromagnetic energy is directed through the chair to produce repeated pelvic-floor muscle contractions.

02 Seated experience

Patients remain fully clothed in a familiar chair-style treatment position.

03 Hands-free delivery

Once the protocol is set and supervised, treatment is designed to proceed without a handheld applicator.

04 Practice-friendly operation

The platform is positioned as non-invasive, operator-independent and free of treatment consumables.

NEUROMUSCULAR ENGAGEMENT

Energy delivered through the seat.

Manufacturer materials describe focused electromagnetic energy penetrating the pelvic-floor area to stimulate deep muscle contractions and support neuromuscular retraining.

01

FOCUSED FIELD

The integrated seat coil directs electromagnetic energy toward the pelvic-floor region.

02

REPEATED CONTRACTION

Rapid stimulation produces repeated contractions that are difficult to reproduce voluntarily.

03

SUPERVISED SESSION

A trained professional selects the protocol and monitors the seated treatment experience.

04

PROGRAM DESIGN

Course length and session spacing are selected according to current labeling and patient needs.

*The original manufacturer brochure presents a 30-minute session and a six-session example scheduled twice weekly. Actual protocols and indications must follow current labeling and professional assessment.

SIMPLE ROOM WORKFLOW

A treatment room that feels familiar.

A chair-form platform helps make pelvic-floor stimulation approachable while keeping setup and supervision straightforward.

Fully clothed

The patient remains dressed throughout the manufacturer-described treatment experience.

02

No handheld applicator

Energy is delivered through the integrated seat rather than a clinician-held treatment head.

03

No treatment consumables

The manufacturer describes the system as consumable-free for routine sessions.

04

Operator-independent cycle

After protocol setup, the cycle is designed to run without continuous manual application.

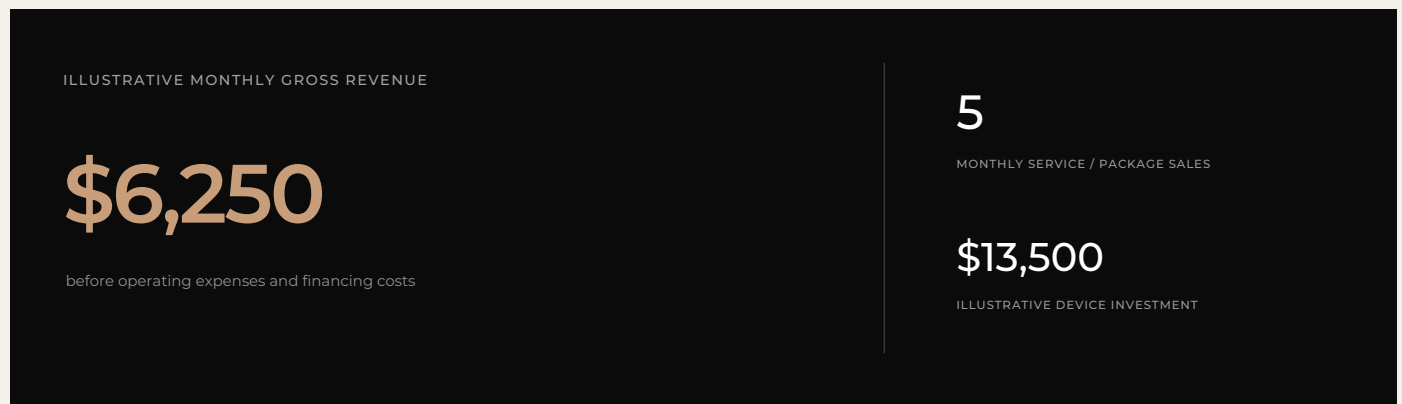

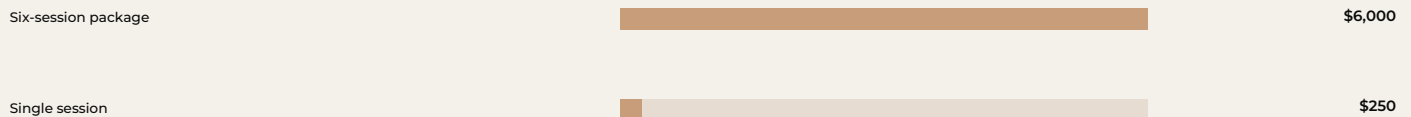
